Everyone can start wearing the new uniform as soon as they wish from Summer term 2016, with up to 2 years for transition to the new uniform if needed — helping to use any of the old uniform kept for siblings. This includes P.E Kit.

The new uniform is compulsory for Reception Class from 2016.
