Attendance

Our child will attend school regularly, on time and "ready to learn".

Children can come into school from 8.50am to 9am. (Before 8.50am please book into Breakfast Club)

Holidays will be avoided at all costs during term time as we understand the negative impact that time out of school has on children's learning.

Always to telephone school on the first day of our child's absence. Also to let school know about any concerns, problems or changes in our family circumstances that may affect our child's work or behaviour.

Respect and a positive attitude for learning.

We will respect, support and uphold the school's policies and rules, including behaviour, anti-bullying and healthy eating/ packed lunch policies.

We will support our child reading and (from Y1) times tables practise every day at home and also with their homework.

We will attend parents' consultations about our child's progress and effort.

We will ensure that our child wears the correct school uniform and school PE/Games kit; all marked with our child's names; no jewellery is worn; no extreme haircuts.
