

Swimming for Y3/4 2016

Swimming for the Lower Junior class starts on Monday 22nd of February. The children will leave school after their lunch at 1.30 and travel by Tyrers coaches to the pool at the All Season's Leisure Centre, Chorley.

The children will be accompanied by Mrs Whittaker, Mrs Milton and Mr Martindale They will have 1 hour of tuition in the pool and return back to school by 3.45pm (traffic permitting).

The children will need a swimming costume; girls a one piece suit, boys a pair of fitted swimming trunks or shorts (not baggy ones), a swimming hat and goggles if preferred. If you want your child to wear goggles **please put this in writing and return to school before the first lesson.**

Mrs Whittaker will be speaking to the children before half term and on the morning of swimming; about the routines , what to expect and behaviour. Please speak to Mrs Whittaker beforehand if there is anything you—or your child—are worried about, or need to know.

It is important all children understand that they must be well behaved and always do what the swimming teacher tells them.

If a child misbehaves they *will* miss the following week's lesson.

This measure is for safety reasons.

The cost to school for the lessons is £6.00 per child per week.

This includes both transport and tuition. PTA have agreed to subsidise swimming by £2.20 per child per week and school will pay £1.80 per child per week. This leaves a shortfall of £2.00 per week per child.

We are asking that you contribute this amount towards the travelling costs as the school budget cannot stretch to the whole amount.

If your child is in receipt of free school meals they will be exempt from this contribution. If you feel that you cannot contribute please see Miss Redmayne in the Office.

Please make the payment of £32 through ParentPay.

We are sorry but refunds cannot be made if your child misses a session.
