

## YOUNG VOICES 1<sup>st</sup> March 2016

### **Arrangements on the day.....**

1. The children will need to bring a packed lunch and a packed tea. It will be much better if these are in a plastic bag so everything can be thrown away after they have eaten (I know it's not very eco friendly but this is an exception) *Please make sure they have enough water to last through a hard afternoon's singing.*
2. Children must wear school uniform . The Young Voices T-shirts or Plain white T-shirt should be brought to school ; we will change into them later on in the afternoon.
3. Young Voices have asked that everyone brings with them 1 tin of food or a packet of something dried. All the food will be handed in as we arrive at the MEN and given to the charity.
4. Lunch will be eaten early, at school.
5. We will be leaving school by coach at 12.30pm ; accompanying teachers: Mrs Annette, Mrs Hodgkinson, Mrs Roberts and Mrs Gell.
6. Each school will have their own banner so when you arrive at the concert you will be able to locate the school by looking for our banner.
7. Parents may have their own banners – useful if sitting on the balcony to help the children locate you.
8. At the end of the concert the exit procedure (for between 6000-9000 children + parents) is organised- but **all** around the arena is very crowded. We will **only** let children go from our MEETING POINT - this is at the front, main entrance of Victoria Station. You will need to pick the children up **before** you go and get your car (why not travel by train?) as you won't be able to pull in, even to just pick up.
9. The children will not need to take any money with them.

Many thanks for your support during the many weeks of rehearsal. Particular thanks to Mrs Hodgkinson and Mrs Annette for teaching the children the many difficult songs and dance moves- which I'm sure you will know as well as your child by now!
