Really good to see Ellen Bate his week– now doing her GCSEs, Ellen came to school as part of the Bolton School Concert Band and also to help out in school that morning too.

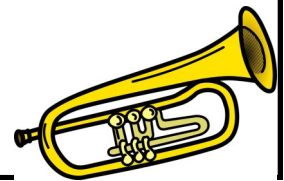
It is always good to see our former pupils and hear of their achievements and aspirations!
