



## Sports Day Information : Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> June

This year Sports Day will be held at Rivington and Blackrod High School who have kindly offered to accommodate us for the afternoon.

Start time is 1.30 until 3.45. Parents will be welcome from 1.15 pm .

Spectators should park in the car park on the right hand side of the road, nearly opposite Rivington Park Independent School. (going towards Horwich) .

Parents *must not* park outside RBHS because access is needed for their school buses. The Sports will take place on the field directly outside RBHS ( front of the school) .

As parents arrive they should see Mrs How to sign in. RBHS have asked for this to be done for child protection reasons. If parents need to use the toilet they should go to the reception of the High School and they will be directed from there.

Children will be having an early lunch on that day. Little Oaks, Reception and Years 1 and 2 will be travelling by coach to the Sports, older children will be walking with their teachers. Children should be collected from RBHS at 3.45 (not before as this will clash with school buses and the high school children leaving)

If your child is going to Late Stay Club on that day then they will be taken back to school by teachers.

Hopefully it will be a warm afternoon -please make sure that your child has a hat with them. We will be taking our normal shelters with us -many thanks to the PTA for their help in this. Each child still needs their own hat and sunscreen. As usual, your children will be given a drink during the afternoon, thanks again to our PTA. Children can take their own water as well.

### **Safety Notes.**

We need to know where all the children are at all times.

We respectfully ask that parents/family members **do not** call their child over to them for any reason. Likewise parents/ family members **are not** allowed to sit or stand with the children. Also keep any small (or large) accompanying visiting children with you at all times and away from the track
