Please be aware:

Dinner Forms

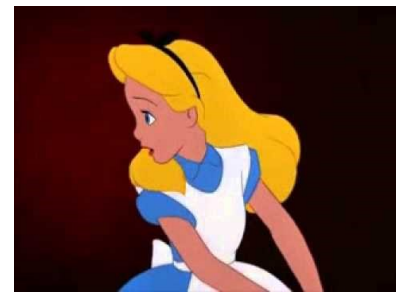
